Seniors to be trained on how to use Price Kaki to compare prices of daily essentials and cooked food

The Consumers Association of Singapore (“CASE”) announced today a collaboration with the Infocomm Media Development Authority (“IMDA”) through its SG Digital Office (“SDO”) to train and guide seniors to compare prices of daily essentials and cooked food through the mobile application Price Kaki. Starting 14 November 2022, seniors will be able to approach SDO Digital Ambassadors at more than 40 SG Digital community hubs across Singapore^[1] to learn how to stretch their dollar and make informed purchasing decisions. CASE and SDO will also be working together to encourage the community to use Price Kaki to compare prices at various roadshows and events.

To raise greater awareness on the benefits of price comparison and what consumers can do to stretch their dollar, CASE targets to recruit and train 1,000 Price Kaki ambassadors by end-2023. These ambassadors would support CASE’s efforts on the ground to monitor and update price changes, expand the list of products available for comparison on Price Kaki, and to encourage usage of the mobile application. The announcement was made this morning at the inaugural workshop held at Radin Mas Community Club attended by Mr Tan Kiat How, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Communications and Information. Minister Tan was hosted by Mr Melvin Yong, President, CASE. Forty-five seniors attended the workshop where they learnt how to download and use Price Kaki to compare prices when shopping for daily essentials and buying cooked food in their neighbourhood.

About Price Kaki

Price Kaki was launched by CASE in September 2019, and the mobile application has been downloaded 122,000 times by users till date.

The key features of Price Kaki will allow users to:

- Compare retail prices and promotions of items;
- Track price changes of items;
- Contribute new retail prices and promotions they come across; and
- Search for nearby supermarkets and hawker centres, coffee shops and food courts.

Mr Tan Kiat How, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Communications and Information said: “Even as we digitalise, we must continue to strengthen our social compact and ensure that no one is left behind. This collaboration between Consumers Association of Singapore (CASE) and SDO is a good example of how seniors will be supported in their digital journey. This is an encouraging effort, and I look forward to more of such initiatives that can help everyone in our society, including seniors.”

Mr Melvin Yong, President, CASE said: “Consumers, especially seniors who may not earn an income, are understandably anxious about making ends meet amidst rising cost of living concerns. We are therefore happy to work with SDO to equip and guide seniors on how to use Price Kaki to compare prices when they shop for daily essentials in their neighbourhood. The seniors can approach SDO Digital Ambassadors at any of the SG Digital community hubs located across Singapore. We will be recruiting Price Kaki ambassadors to support our efforts on the ground to monitor and update price changes, increase the list of products available for comparison on Price Kaki, and to encourage usage of the mobile application. We target to recruit and train 1,000 ambassadors by end-2023. Through these initiatives, we hope to help more consumers, in particular our seniors, to stretch their dollar on daily essentials.”

Mr Douglas Goh, Director, SG Digital Office and Digital for Life Secretariat said: “The SG Digital Office (SDO) is supportive of initiatives that help Singaporean embrace digital as a way of life. We are always looking out for meaningful mobile applications to share with Singaporeans, especially our seniors, to help them appreciate how a simple digital solution like the Price Kaki app can benefit and add value to their daily lives. In the last two years, more than 190,000 seniors have benefitted from SDO’s Basic Digital Skills curriculum and have continued to use the skills they learnt. Digitalisation can truly enrich and transform the lives of our seniors. And we welcome more seniors to connect with our Digital Ambassadors to pick up new digital skills.”
